Greetings!

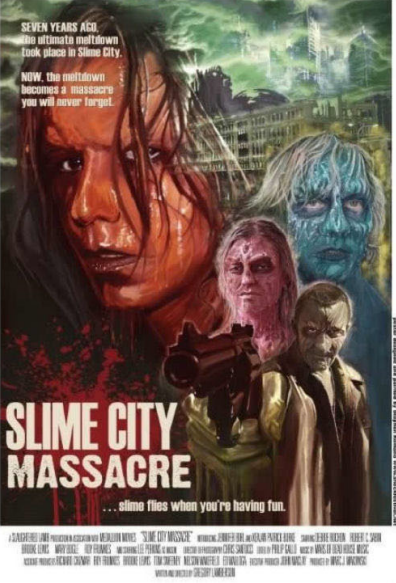
